

**ORCHARD PARK JAYCEES
EARNING BY LEARNING PROGRAM
Rules and Regulations**

Children MUST be supervised by a parent each week.

**The Orchard Park Jaycees accept NO responsibility for your child's safety and/or whereabouts.*
Any child left alone in the Library will be asked to leave the program.*

- The program will be held at the Orchard Park Library from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. (last sign in time), as follows:

Thursday, July 15th
Thursday, July 22nd
Thursday, July 29th
Thursday, August 12th (Check Dispensing Only)

- The program is open to children entering Grades 2 through 5 in September 2010.
- There is seven (7) book maximum per week. Children will earn \$1.00 per book read from the Approved National Elementary School Reading List, up to 7 books per week. The reading lists can be found at www.OPJaycees.com
- Children MUST sign in by 7:30 p.m. to be interviewed on any given week. Please plan on spending at least an hour each Thursday.
- **Books must be presented at each weekly review session to be eligible for credit. Do not forget the book.**
- All of the books read must appear on the Approved Reading List. To ensure that the books are age/reading level appropriate, all books must be selected from the Approved Reading List that is based upon the grade the child is entering in September 2010. Please let us know if your child is at a different reading level so that we can provide you with a list that is appropriate. ANY BOOKS NOT ON THE APPROVED READING LIST WILL NOT COUNT UNLESS PRE-APPROVED BY LIBRARY STAFF AND JAYCEE CHAIRMAN.
- No written reports will be accepted. The child must be in attendance to receive credit. There are no “make-up” nights allowed for any weeks missed.
- Child should come prepared to discuss books on July 15th. **The top portion of the Summary Sheets/Interview Sheets MUST be filled out before interview process.**
- There is no cost for this program. However, parents MUST volunteer at least two nights per child registered. Please notify the Jaycees if you need to change the night that you volunteered for. If the parent of participating child does not volunteer two of the three nights, the child may not receive full credit for books read. It is only with parent assistance can we accept an unlimited number of children to the program, at this time. Email us of any changes to: OPJaycees@aol.com.
- **Parents who signed up to volunteer for two nights MUST arrive at the Library by 6:15 p.m. and be prepared to interview children until 8:00 p.m. Please bring a pen with you for filling out Interview Sheets.**
- All money earned will be handed out at the Awards Night at the Orchard Park Library on August 12th. You must tell us if you will not be attending that night and we will make arrangements to mail checks out. Checks may take up to two weeks to be mailed.
- This program is designed to keep your child(ren) reading over the Summer, while having FUN. The volunteers are not teachers or reading specialists.
